

CORE: MEMBERS *CONSTITUTION*

I. MEMBERSHIP

All categories of membership are by invitation only, and all nominees must be sponsored by a current member. Prospective members of CORE: are reviewed by an International Membership Committee. The selected members will then meet with CORE: founders, who are responsible for the final admittance decision.

II. PRINCIPLES

Every member is invited to be part of the CORE: community because of their compelling individuality. Yet, when it came time to create the CORE: Member Constitution, we were confronted with the question of how to create guidelines for such a strikingly diverse group of individuals. We knew that to be true to our original vision, we had to conceive a constitution that would ensure that CORE: remains a community of ultimate serenity, ease and fulfilment - for everyone. As always, we turned to our members for direction about the qualities that they believe create an essential and seductive environment. We also relied on intuition and inference. Much of how we conduct ourselves at CORE: is based on these qualities. What do we know, in our hearts, and through knowledge and experience, to be good, right, and true? What are the conditions that allow people to be profoundly connected and engaged? We have faith that thoughtfulness, sensitivity, and imagination, the basis of the CORE: community, can peacefully resolve any issue which might arise along the way.

III. CONFIDENTIALITY

- Privacy is an integral aspect of CORE: culture.
- The CORE: team will keep the names of all members confidential.
- Communications between members and between members and their guests are meant to remain confidential, unless an explicit agreement exists otherwise.

The substance and details of CORE: conversations is not to be used for journalistic, promotional, or commercial purposes.

- Communicating confidential information about CORE:, its members, and team to the media is not permitted, unless specifically granted in writing.

IV. SERVICE

- There are no cash transactions at CORE:
- All services and usage are paid by previously provided credit card number. Members are required to keep their accounts current. Members receive an itemized monthly statement at the end of each month.
- CORE: members are provided with the highest quality of service. Therefore, no temporary outside providers (caterers, chefs, trainers, spa therapists, beauty aestheticians, etc) are allowed to serve members inside CORE:

V. GUESTS & SECURITY

- CORE: gladly welcomes its members' guests, although they must be accompanied by a member at all times.
- To ensure that guests are given the proper care and attention,

members are required to notify our Member Experience Team prior to arrival.

- Guests of a Founding Member may visit the club without being accompanied by the member. Founding Members are required to notify our Member Experience Team prior to arrival.
- The same guest may visit CORE: no more than 12 times per year.
- Members are responsible for their guests' behaviour. They must adhere to the CORE: code of conduct.
- All guest charges will be billed to the member's account.
- If members and/or their guests are accompanied by personal security while visiting CORE: members should notify our team prior to their arrival.

VI. CONDUCT

- All mobile devices are allowed in most CORE: spaces. We ask that members put their devices on vibrate or silent when entering CORE:
- To guarantee members' desire for privacy, no cameras or video equipment are to be used inside CORE: without prior consent of the Member Experience team
- There is no strict dress code. CORE: members are free to express their individuality.
- The CORE: service model requires a certain level of maturity from all participants, team and members alike. As a result, children under the age of 13 are not allowed, with the exception of weekend activities. Children aged 13 or over are welcome in the restaurant and must always be accompanied by a member. For all other areas of CORE:, including our Cultural Program events, guests must be at least 18 years old.
- Pets are not allowed. However, exceptions can be made for very well-behaved furry members upon regular request. This also applies to our suites.
- Members engaging in disorderly, disrespectful or unruly conduct that infringes upon basic membership rights will be asked to leave CORE: and will result in immediate termination of CORE: membership.
- Intentional damage or theft of property will not be tolerated and will result in immediate termination of CORE: membership.
- As the CORE: team is carefully chosen to deliver the best service experience, we expect that they are treated with the utmost respect; any personal, verbal or physical attack will not be tolerated and will result in termination of the membership.
- CORE: and its team are not liable for any loss, including theft of personal property, or injury to any CORE: member or their guests occurring within the premises.

VII. RESERVATIONS

- Members are encouraged to utilise the spaces of CORE: to host their own private events. Members can organise events with our Special Events Team, who have a complete knowledge of space availability.
- For all Cultural Program events reservations must be made, as space can be limited.
- As a home away from home, we offer members the convenience of booking our suites with our Member Experience Team.
